## **Anti-Social Behaviour, Crime and Policing Act 2014**

### **DRAFT North Somerset District Council (Weston-super-Mare Seafront) Public Space Protection Order XXXX**

1. This Order may be cited as the North Somerset District Council (Weston-super-Mare Seafront) Public Space Protection Order 20XX
2. This Order shall commence on the date it is made and cease to be of effect on the XXXX
3. This Order applies to the public spaces specified in Schedule 1 and imposes restrictions as set out in Schedule 2.
4. It is an offence for a person, without reasonable excuse:
  - (a) to do anything a person is prohibited from doing by schedule 2 of this order, or
  - (b) to fail to comply with a requirement to which the person is subject by schedule 2 of this order
5. A person guilty of an offence under condition (a) or (b) of article 4 of this order, is liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding level 3 on the standard scale or fixed penalty notice of a maximum £ 75.

## **Schedule 1**

### **1. Public spaces within North Somerset District Council failing within the following categories**

Any public space in the open air, including covered land which is open on at least one side and to which the public is entitled or permitted to have access (with or without payment) within the boundary delineated for identification purposes only on the maps below.

## **Schedule 2**

### **Restrictions**

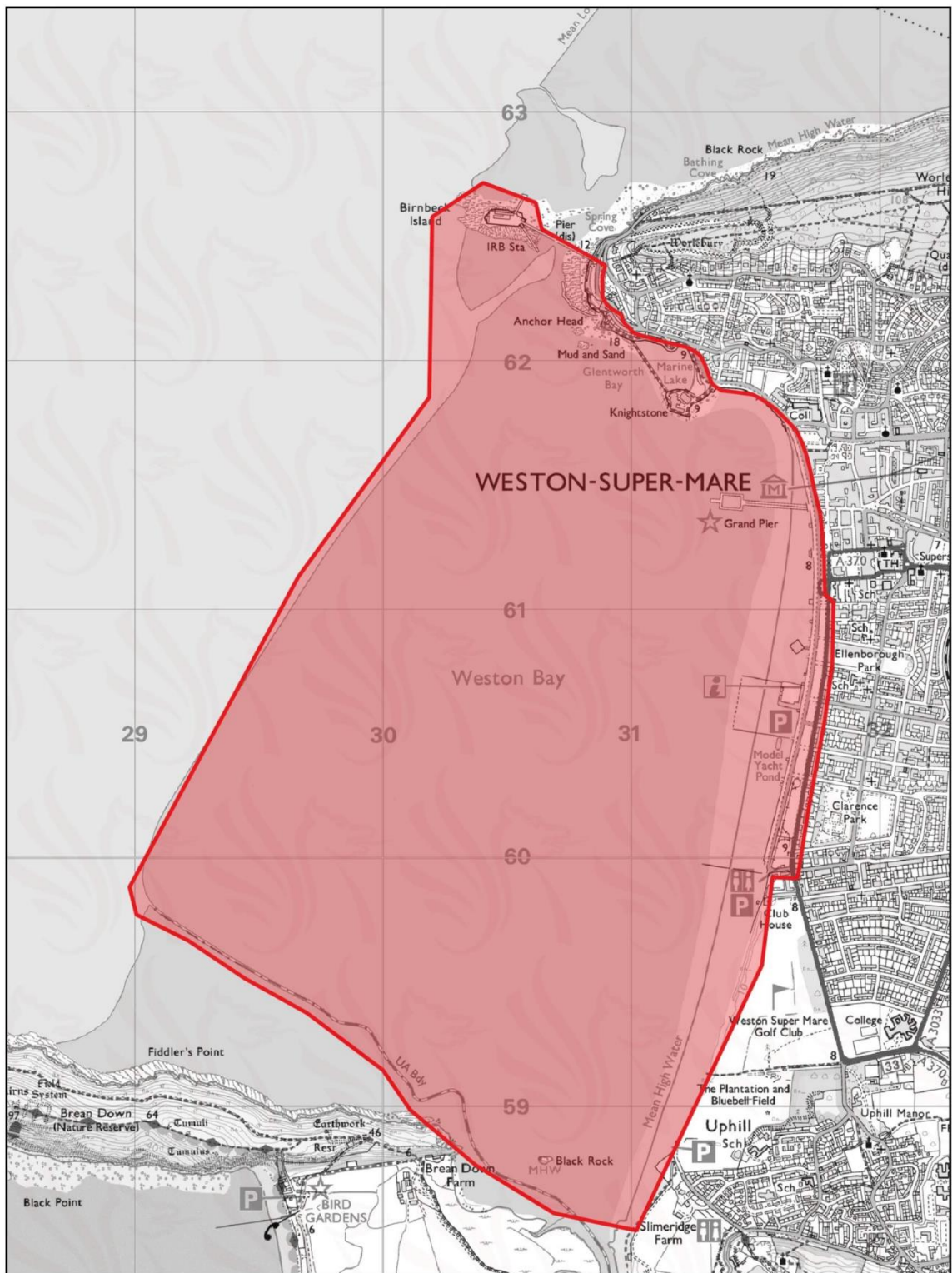
- (1) No person without a reasonable excuse shall act in an anti-social or disorderly manner that causes or is likely to cause nuisance, harassment, alarm or distress to any other person.
- (2) No person shall obstruct:
  - (a) any officer of the Council in the proper execution of their duties;
  - (b) any person carrying out an act which is necessary to the proper execution of any contract with the Council
- (3) No person at any time shall provide or deposit food for consumption by birds within “the Controlled Zone”
- (4) No person shall light a fire or Chinese lantern within “the Controlled Zone”
- (5) If instructed to do so by a police officer or an authorised officer a person shall clear away any tent, gazebo, marquee or other temporary structure and associated equipment without delay.
- (6) Person(s) (by definition includes the driver or registered keeper of the vehicle if the driver cannot be identified who at the time of the offence was in control of the vehicle or in a position to control its use within the area) are prohibited from:
  - (a) Launching any personal watercraft or sailing vessels within the “controlled zone” other than from Knightstone Slipway.
  - (b) Entering any marked exclusion zones with a powered watercraft
  - (c) Using, driving or sailing watercraft or a vehicle in a manner likely to cause alarm, harassment, distress or public nuisance
  - (d) Parking a vehicle on the Knightstone Slipway, Promenade or Marine Lake Plaza without prior permission.
  - (e) Causing an obstruction on the Knightstone Slipway, Promenade, public highway or publicly accessible place within the “Controlled Zone”.

(6) If a Police Constable or Authorised Person reasonably believes that a person has acted, or likely to act, contrary to the restrictions placed upon them by this Order, they must provide their name and address when required to do so.

(7) If a Police Constable or Authorised Person reasonably believes that a person has acted, or likely to act, contrary to the restrictions placed upon them by this Order, they must leave “the Controlled Zone” or specified location forthwith and not return within a specified period up to a maximum of 48 hours when instructed to do so by a Police Constable or Authorised Person.
